

Quinine Hydrochloride Used as a beverage flavor (tonic water) and an

injectable drug for the

treatment of malaria.



Quinine Sulphate

Used as an Active Pharmaceutical Ingredient (API) for the treatment of malaria and leg cramps.



Quinine Dihydrochloride

Commonly used as an API in injectable drugs for the treatment of malaria.



Quinine Base Anhydrous

Used as an Active Pharmaceutical Ingredient (API) for medicated creams and to treat leg cramps.



Quinine Bisulphate Used as an injectable drug for the treatment of malaria.

Quinidine Base

Used as a base for antiarrhythmic drugs. Under development to treat some nervous system disorders.



Quinidine Sulphate

Used as a basic ingredient of antiarrhythmic drugs. Currently used as Medicare to treat pseodobulbar effect.



Cinchonine

Commonly used as a catalyst in the production of certain pesticides.



Cinchonidine

Used as a catalyst in the production of some APIs.

Quinine salts or kinins were first isolated in 1820 from the bark of the quinine tree which is native to Peru, and their molecular formula was determined by Adolf Strecker in 1854. The group of chemical compounds it belongs to is called quinine alkaloids. Extracts of quinine tree bark have been used to treat malaria since at least 1632 and were introduced to Europe (Spain) by Jesuit missionaries returning from the New World.

In the late 19th century the Dutch planted this plant on Indonesian plantations, they became the main suppliers of the tree. In 1913 the Dutch government established the Quinine Bureau, a cartel of quinine producers in charge of controlling prices and production. By the 1930s, Dutch plantations in Java had produced 22 million pounds of quinine bark, or 97% of world quinine production at the time.


Until recently, Kinin was a drug used to treat malaria and babesiosis. The drug covers the treatment of malaria due to chloroquine-resistant Plasmodium falciparum when artesunate is not available. Kinin is also used as an ingredient in tonic water to impart a bitter taste.




Essential oils have a very complex substance and are formed from many components that are difficult to identify. Taken from leaves, flower petals, pistils, to tree bark.




